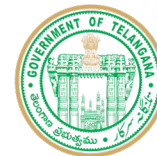

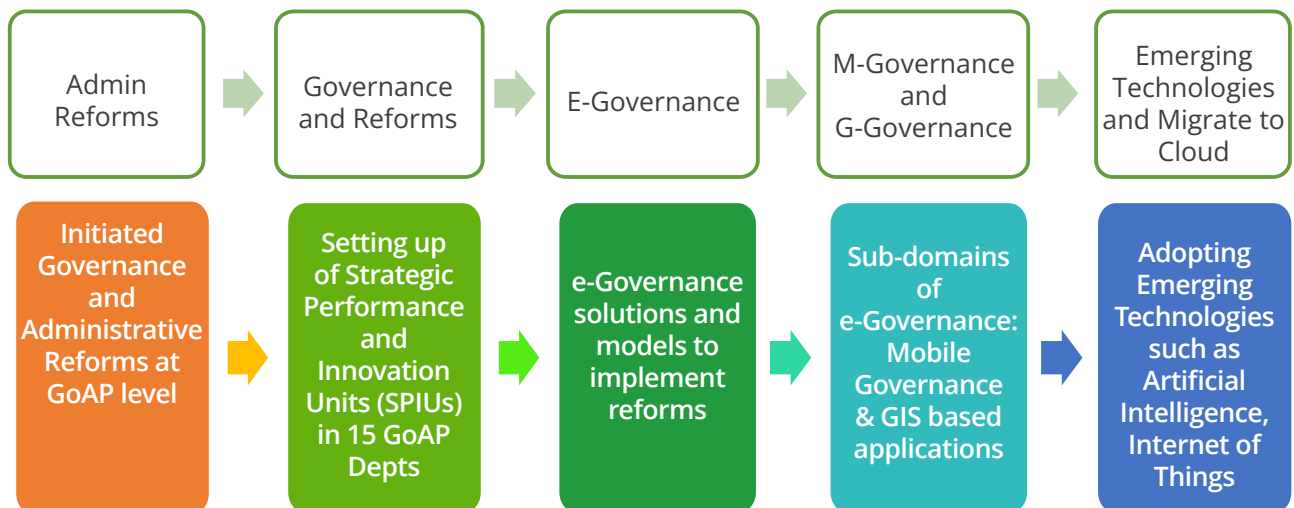

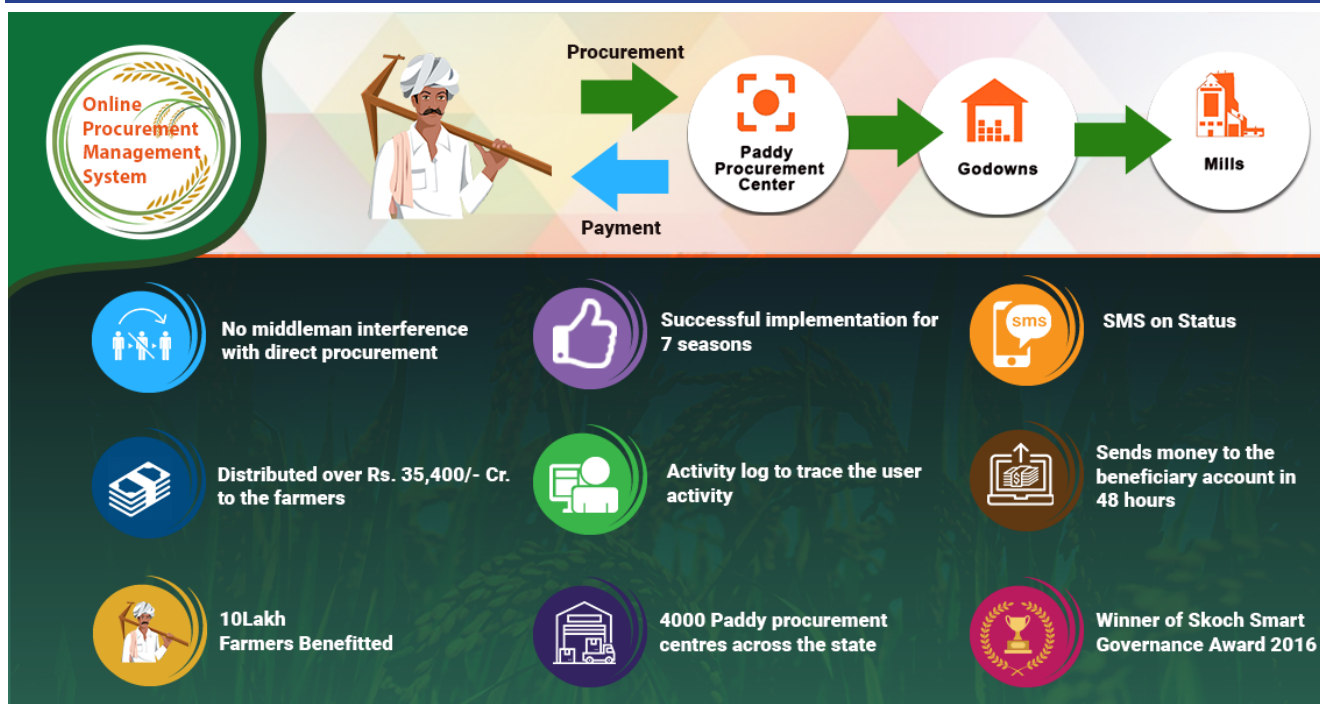
PLANT QUARANTINE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (PQMS) & COMPREHENSIVE REGISTRATION OF PESTICIDES (CROP), MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE & FARMER WELFARE, GOI

Plant Quarantine Management System for Online Import Release and Export Process Systems, facilitates Importers to apply online for Import Permit/ Release Order and Exporters to apply online for Phyto-Sanitary Certificate. The system shall be deployed in 67 quarantine stations across the country.

Comprehensive Registration of Pesticides for Online Certification of Pesticide Registration, facilitates online submission of applications, registration fee payment through net banking and other payment modes, Scrutiny by CIB&RC officials, issue of registration certificates to the pesticides across the country.

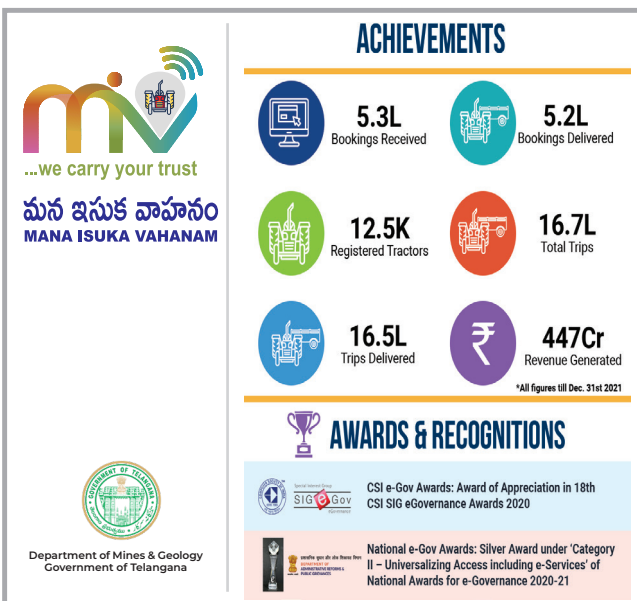
- In Telangana OBMMS is successfully implemented by 18 Welfare Corporations / Federations and 22 Welfare Corporations in AP.

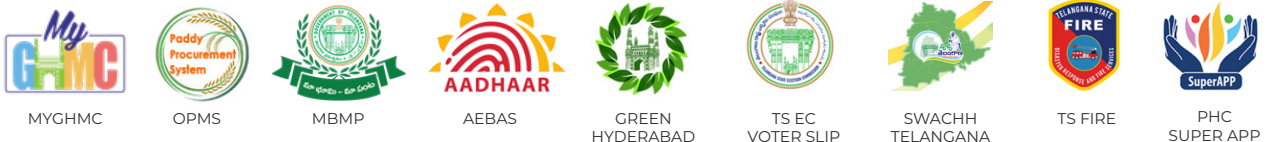

The State of Telangana is a pioneer in offering its services through mobile Governance.

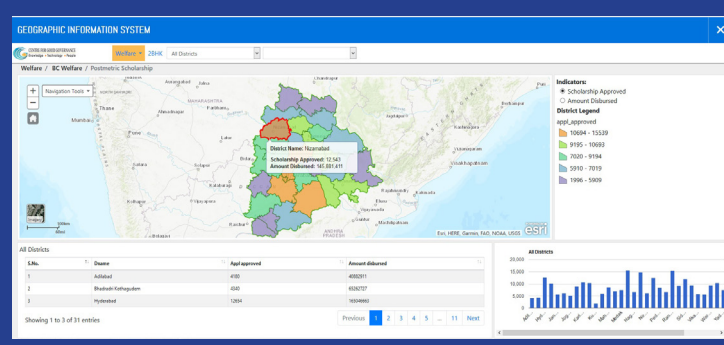
Centre for Good Governance is associated with the Telangana Government to promote m-Governance across Governments by developing mobile-based applications.

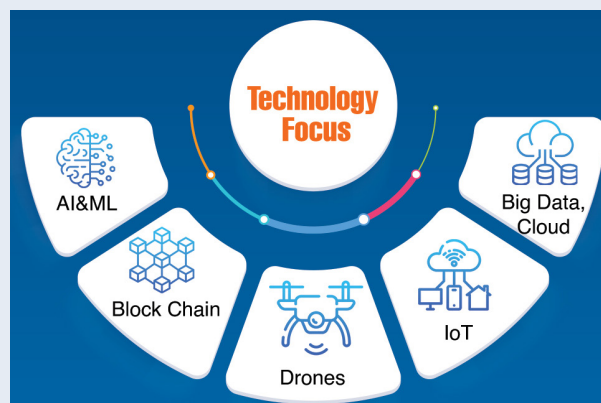
